- 1. The current conditions of the 4 factories in Japan

 - 2) Yamagata Factory --- as usual
 - 3) Fukushima Factory and Ishinomaki Factory

The production lines as well as equipment/infrastructures have been under checking process since the occurrence of the earthquake.
